The first part of the afternoon meeting presented some of the advanced distribution features of MAS 500; the top of the line Sage product. Honestly, I doubt anyone at the meeting was very interested in this part. Finally Sage turned to

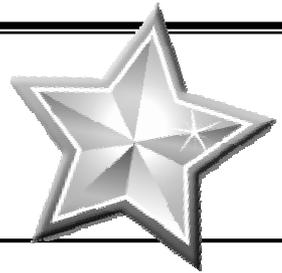
presenting MAS 90 and MAS 200 version 4.30 which is due to start shipping in late summer this year.

The biggest news about the new release will be that most paperless office enhancements will now be included at no additional charge! If you are currently using paperless office, you will no longer be charged a maintenance fee every year. These enhancements will automatically keep a PDF copy of every journal and register and organize them for easy retrieval. This will free up a lot of file cabinet space and make finding data a lot easier in the future.

The Business Insights Explorer, a very popular part of version 4.20, will be expanded in 4.30 to include data from AP and GL modules. Also 4.30 will be supported on 64bit Microsoft operating systems.

Note: We will need to wait until version 4.40 in 2009 for the purchase order and inventory modules to be upgraded to the new business framework.

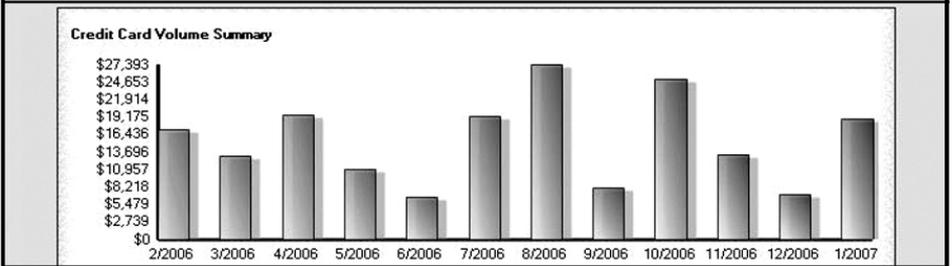

Cook Paging, a privately owned corporation, is a West Coast Provider of messaging and pager service in Washington, Oregon, California, and Arizona. The company's mission is to provide reliable services at a low cost and to maintain exceptional customer service.

To meet its growing business needs Cook Paging decided to switch from a DOS package to a Windows based software. After reviewing industry ratings and features of several software solutions, Cook Paging implemented MAS 90 in 2005. "It seemed to fit our needs as the best solution," states David Yam, Controller, adding "We liked the feel of the software, the ability to navigate easily, and the report-writing features with drill-down options." The report-writing features are a great advantage as the supporting reports needed to be

prepared by hand prior to implementing MAS 90. Yam makes great use of the FRx Reporting capabilities noting that he can now "prepare a variety of financial reports and then send specific information to multiple users via email." Additionally, the reports can be printed or exported into popular formats resulting in timely and accurate processing of information.

In addition to the MAS 90 modules, Cook Paging took advantage of custom enhancements such as the PAS AP Repetitive Invoice Processor. The MAS 90 screen requires the user to complete information about the Cycle, Vendor No., and Reference for each invoice to be processed. Unless the invoices to be selected have common attributes such as Cycle or Reference, each invoice has to be selected one at a time.

Cook Paging has telephone and rent vendors, each with a large number of accounts and therefore selected one invoice at a time is

laborious and time-consuming. The PAS Repetitive Invoice Processor allows the user to see all the repetitive invoices on one screen and make desired selections for as many or few invoices at the same time in one process. This was the selling point for Yam who notes that the enhancement has allowed invoice information to be more accessible and the selection process less cumbersome.

“Working with Jon and the PAS team has been very enjoyable. I always get an immediate response and a resolution to any issues encountered,” concludes Yam.

Client Server (CS) **Open Database Connectivity (ODBC)**

Do you want your reports to go faster? If you are using MAS 200 version 4.20 and have the need for faster reporting speed then Client Server ODBC is the solution for you! Client Server ODBC, or CS ODBC for short, allows you to run reports at server speed right from your workstation.



As Sage is upgrading MAS 90 and MAS 200, the new modules are using Crystal Reports to maintain all forms and reports. This gives us some great advantages for customization, but since Crystal runs on your workstation rather than the server, your reporting speed is now more limited by your network bandwidth. If you are running MAS 200 from a remote location from your server, you will almost certainly need the CS ODBC for printing forms and reports.

How does it work? When a report is requested is sent over the network to the server from the workstation of the user that requested it. The MAS 200 process on the server then processes the query for all the data necessary to generate the report and sends it back over to the workstation. Once it arrives, the workstation then processes it again by sorting and filtering it to get only the information that was requested by the user, in the order that it was requested to be presented in. Both the process of sending the data and organizing the data on the workstation level take a tremendous amount of resources.

This is where the CS ODBC comes in. It allows MAS200 to process the report entirely at the server. So, only the finished product of the report is sent back over the network to the workstation for display. Viola! CS ODBC runs your report at server speed.

Every distribution company ships products to customers. Maintaining customer satisfaction and managing inventory are two challenges facing the shipping department. Prioritizing which orders should be shipped each day is a large part of both of these challenges.

The shipping manager needs answers to many questions:

- Do we have all items in stock?
- Does the customer accept backorders?
- Does the order have a ship date? A cancel if not shipped by date?
- What is the priority of this customer?
- Is the customer on credit hold or over their credit limit?

The current MAS system is paper based. All picking sheets are printed, and then prioritized manually. The **PAS Picking Control Center** will display all open sales orders, identify the highest priority orders, label which orders can be sent 100% complete, and present the percentage on others, show the order, promise and cancel dates, and the customer activity level, credit limit, and open balance.

The list can be automatically prioritized or sorted by any field, and each order and/or group of orders can be selected for picking sheet printing. As each order

is selected for shipping, the available quantities to the other orders are adjusted appropriately. When all of the shipping has been selected, the picking sheets can be automatically printed.

Note: This new enhancement to MAS 90 and MAS 200 will be available to the general public in June 2008. It requires version 4.10 or higher and the Business Objects Interface.

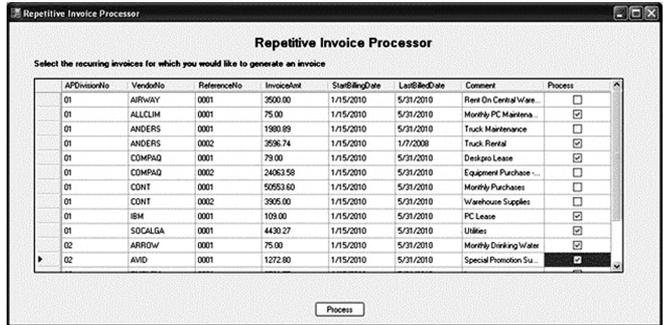
PAS AP Repetitive Invoice Processor:

A must for all Accounts Payable users

Selecting repetitive invoices in standard MAS 90 or MAS 200 AP is cumbersome and prone to human error. Many clients choose to manually enter their rent, phone, utility, and other regular monthly bills because using this feature is so difficult. It is impossible to see what you are selecting until after you have processed your selection. It is also difficult to select a single invoice for processing.

With the new **PAS AP Repetitive Invoice Processor**,

all important fields are displayed for the user's reference and each invoice may be selected individually. The list may be re-sorted in any sequence by clicking on the column heading. You can easily see if the invoice has been previously processed, and after processing the invoice will be removed from the window to prevent duplicate selection.
